Theme	What are the main challenges of development in Kilombero Valley and how can they be solved?
Background	Tanzania is often listed as one of the fastest growing African economies achieving GDP growth well above the regional average and consistently scoring around 7% growth per annum. Unfortunately, this growth is not always felt throughout all layers of society and we would like to understand if this growth is felt in the Kilombero Valley and if not what the obstacles are. Areas that we would like the participants to focus on are: Do you feel Tanzania's growth is seen in equal measure in the Kilombero Valley? What are ways development and economic growth can be effectively measured in the Kilombero Valley? How students perceive their own past, present and future development trajectory? How development can be influenced by members of students' household? What roles do local & national governments play and how should companies and NGOs interact to drive development Contestants are challenged to describe their ideas, own observations and experiences in your society. We like you to be critical about your own role as well as KVTC's role.
Guidelines	Eligibility: O-level secondary school students from Itete, Iragua, Igota, Lupiro, Ikungua, Ulanga, Minepa na Matundu secondary schools Essays must be 1,000-1,200 words and be in English language. Word count excludes essay title and cover page. Essays may be typed or printed Essays must have: a) cover page, b) essay title, c) name of author, d) address and contact details, e) age of author at time of writing, f) gender, g) school name and h) word count Each school is required to select the best three candidates and submit these essays to KVTC On submission please enclose the contact information of the submitting school and the assigned teacher. Entries may be submitted by email or in person Entries missing any of the above information will not be considered Essays must be original and unpublished Essays must be written by one person. Co-authored essays are not accepted A panel consisting of KVTC management will be assigned to do the final grading of the submitted essays (8 school x 3 essays per school = 24 essays) Copyright of the essays entered will be assigned to the organizer Entries must be received by October 26th, 2018
